Bottlenose Dolphins at Marineland

- Echo - female approximately 28-31 years of age, captured 2000 from Black Sea in Russia
 - Lida - female approximately 28-31 years of age, captured 2000 from Black Sea in Russia
 - Calf - born May 2003 and died sometime in 2003, presumed
 - Marina - female approximately 28-31 years of age, captured 2001 from Black Sea in Russia
 - Tsunami - female approximately 28-31 years of age, captured 2001 from Black Sea in Russia
- **There was another calf born in 2005 that also died in 2005, unsure of the mother*

Mystic Aquarium currently has 5 belugas in total: 3 belugas from Marineland:

- Juno - male, born at Marineland 2002, mother Denise (captured 1999 - died 2005)
 - Moved to Seaworld Orlando 2006
 - Moved to Mystic Aquarium 2010
- Jetta - female, born 2014 at Marineland, mother Skyla
 - Moved to Mystic Aquarium 2021
- Sahara - female, born 2014 at Marineland, mother Acadia
 - Moved to Mystic Aquarium 2021

Seaworld San Diego currently has 3 belugas in total, 1 from Marineland:

- Klondike - male, born at Marineland 2002, mother Xena
 - Moved to Seaworld Orlando 2006
 - Moved to Seaworld San Diego 2014

Seaworld SanAntonio currently has 10 belugas, none from Marineland

- Martha was a 40 year old beluga that had been at Sea World San Antonio since the park opened in 1988. Captured on July 17, 1988 in Hudson Bay, Manitoba Canada, Martha had 4 calves over her life span. According to SeaWorld: "Martha was critical within her pod and shaped generations of animal care specialists."

Seaworld Orlando currently has 2 belugas, none from Marineland

Shedd Aquarium currently has 8 belugas in total, 1 beluga from Marineland:

- Aurek - male, born at Marineland 2003, mother Gemini
 - Moved to SeaWorld Orlando 2006
 - Moved to Georgia Aquarium 2016
 - Moved to Shedd Aquarium 2017

***Bears** – Three bears were moved from Marineland to a sanctuary due to cramped conditions and adequate water availability.

- Sasha, a male bear, was moved and was formally adopted in November 2022.
- The two female bears, named Maple and Sugar, were moved in February 2023.

Cetacean –

- Five belugas (Jetta, Sahara, Havok, Havana, Kharabali) sold for research and moved in May 2021. All the whales had pre-existing health conditions at the time of purchase.

- Havok was sedated 5 times for the transfer. He was 5 years old and underweight at the time of death, in August 2021.
- Havana died February 2022.
- Kharabali died December 2023.

- Kiska the orca, at Marineland since 1979, she had 5 calves that all died young. Kiska she died March 10, 2023 of a bacterial infection. The full necropsy report was never released.
- Eighteen belugas and one dolphin whose names are not known have died at Marineland since 2019.
- Eos 7 years old beluga sick since birth was euthanized in February 2025.

Sea Lions Holly & Maui - two 18-year-old females, are now acclimating in the B.C. Wild

Coast outdoor gallery in a separate pool from the other sea lions. They are mature animals, and our responsibility is to support their long-term health and quality of life,” said Mackenzie Neale, director of animal care at Vancouver Aquarium.
